The remaining options become exercisable, if at all, if the average closing price per share of Class A Common Stock of the Company equals or exceeds the applicable target price per share for 20 consecutive trading days on or before the applicable dates as follows: (i) 289,000 shares at each of the following target prices and target dates: \$6.25 by December 31, 2024, \$6.75 by December 31, 2024, \$7.25 by December 31, 2025; and (ii) 288,000 shares if the target price of \$7.75 is reached by December 31, 2025.
- 166,666 options vested on January 1, 2021 and 166,668 will vest on January 1, 2022.
